Notes:

Continuing fees are reduced fees for students not in residence at that institution or for years beyond year 2. Students always pay fees to each university for all terms in the program. If Terms rather than Years are alternated, then the same total amount of fees must be collected.

Both Universities will attempt to provide adequate financial support to a JDP Student, so that a student will not need to pay more fees than required for a "normal" PhD at either University. As a JDP Student is enrolled in both institutions, a JDP Student may apply for financial support from both Universities, subject to any restriction of either University.
